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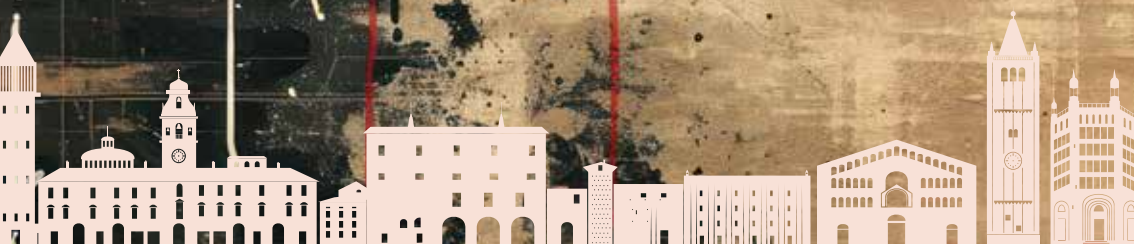

Razionale

For the first time, the Cardioparma Congress, in its IV edition 2025, takes on a multidisciplinary and departmental guise, with an interactive cardiology and cardiac surgery program.

We are deeply convinced that this collaboration, already present on the clinical level, can express a new joint strength, especially in the discussion of increasingly multidisciplinary issues, concerning increasingly complex patients affected by multiple pathologies.

It aims to be a conference that focuses on the innovations in both interventional cardiology and cardiac surgery in the panorama of coronary and valvular pathologies. The ultimate goal is to analyze both all the percutaneous techniques, and also the minimally invasive, micro-invasive and robotic surgical approaches for an update and an interactive discussion aimed at the modern and adequate definition of the new technological resources for the treatment of cardiovascular pathologies that can be resolved through personalized procedures for the patient.

There are focuses dedicated to cardiovascular prevention, but the topics of arrhythmia therapy, aortic pathologies and a session dedicated to heart failure will also be addressed.

The sessions will feature debates between cardiologists and cardiac surgeons experts of the different methods in comparison on major themes that we are led to face daily in clinical practice, guided and conveyed by readings on the different hot topics.

The faculty is enriched by the contributions of expert cardiologists and cardiac surgeons of the highest profile both Italian and from European centers of absolute prestige. The conference also wants to be an opportunity to promote the academic history of Parma as both Cardiology and Cardiac Surgery are home to Schools of Specialization with great experience and professionalism gained over many years of activity.
