POSITIONS

The PhD Programs "Molecular Medicine" (MolMed), Immune Modulation in Respiratory Diseases (RespImmun) and "Inflammatory Disorders in Pregnancy" (DP-iDP) offer 23 PhD positions with a special focus on cancer research, immunology, bioinformatics, cardiovascular research, microbiome and aging. As a PhD student, you will be embedded in an interdisciplinary community of supervisors, fellow students and administrative support. PhD students receive a 3-year contract (1 initial year + 2 years extension) including a competitive salary and social benefits.
